## JUDICIAL ASSISTANT OF THE SENIOR COURTS OF BELIZE

Applicants for the position of Judicial Assistant:

- [a] must possess a Bachelor of Laws Degree and a Certificate in Legal Education or equivalent qualification and be qualified to practice as an attorney-at-law or as an advocate in a court in any other part of the Commonwealth having unlimited jurisdiction either in civil or criminal causes or matters, and be called to the Bar in a Commonwealth country; and
- [b] must be in good health.
- [c] must be a person who conducts himself at all times, both in his professional and personal life, in a matter that will maintain public confidence in the standards of the judiciary.

Applicants are also expected to possess a high level of personal integrity and if successful are expected to subscribe to any Judicial Code of Ethics that the Chief Justice may from time to time prescribe.
